5. **Election of Committee Members**

Chairperson of the meeting must declare all positions on the Committee vacant. Returning Officer to take over proceedings.

Nominations

5a.

Prior to the election of each position, the Chairperson of the meeting must call for nominations to fill that position. An eligible member of the Association may: nominate himself or herself; or with the member's consent, be nominated by another member.

A member who is nominated for a position and fails to be elected to that position may be nominated for any other position for which an election is yet to be held.

If the number of members nominated exceeds the number to be elected, a ballot must be held. If a ballot is required for the election for a position, the Chairperson of the meeting must appoint a member to act as returning officer to conduct the ballot. The returning officer must not be a member nominated for the position. Before the ballot is taken, each candidate may make a short speech in support of his or her election. The election must be by secret ballot. The returning officer must give a blank piece of paper to - each member present in person; and each proxy appointed by a member.

9. Progressive Atheists Branches

Following are the proposed additions (**shown in bold**) to be added to the model Rules in order to allow for the creation of Progressive Atheists Branches:

4 Definitions

In these Rules—

Branches, means a subsidiary local group who takes on the name of "Progressive Atheists (name of local area)". For example: "Progressive Atheists Perth" or "Progressive Atheists Ballarat".

- 5 Powers of Association
- (1) Subject to the Act, the Association has power to do all things incidental or conducive to achieve its purposes.
- (2) Without limiting subrule (1), the Association may—
- (a) acquire, hold and dispose of real or personal property;
- (b) open and operate accounts with financial institutions;
- (c) invest its money in any security in which trust monies may lawfully be invested;
- (d) raise and borrow money on any terms and in any manner as it thinks fit;
- (e) secure the repayment of money raised or borrowed, or the payment of a debt or liability;
- (f) appoint agents to transact business on its behalf;
- (g) enter into any other contract it considers necessary or desirable.
- (h) facilitate the operation of Branches in accordance with a structure determined by the committee.

10. Purpose Statement

Our current Purpose Statement reads as follows:

Progressive Atheists Incorporated (PA Inc) is an organisation of like-minded individuals who want to affect a progressive social transformation within their local community.

We seek to fulfill the following purposes:

- 1. To foster functional democracy within PA Inc, its processes, procedures and activities:
- 2. To provide effective accountability of those entrusted with PA Inc leadership;
- 3. To fight for secular ideals and freedom from religion;
- 4. To act in solidarity with other progressive movements, organisations and groups that share our commitment to voicing issues affecting women, minorities, people with disabilities, gays and lesbians, seniors, youth and the environment;
- 5. To improve communication among progressive groups and organisations in our community in order to galvanise a united front for promoting secularism.

In April the committee was approached by a founding member of Progressive Atheists with a request to update our Purpose Statement. This initiated a long discussion within the committee and further consultation with all members.

The initial concerns raise were to clarify our secular aims and distinguish ourselves from hate groups. As the committee continued the discussion additional concerns were raised regarding the freedom to speak out against harmful religious views and the lack of content regarding universal human rights, social justice and ethics.

Our aim as a committee has been to maintain the spirit of the original Purpose Statement, whilst adding improvements that enhance the value and meaning of the original purpose statement.

This has led us to propose the following changes and additions to the Purpose Statement as shown in **bold** on the next page.

Purpose Statement Proposal:

- 4. To improve communication among progressive groups and organisations in our community in order to galvanise a united front for promoting secularism;
- 5. To strive for a secular society that grants personal and political freedom from religion, whilst retaining personal freedom of religion and personal freedom of conscience;
- 6. To create a safe and inclusive environment within which people are encouraged to discuss their ideas honestly, debate social and cultural values, develop ethics, promote social justice and contribute to universal human rights;
- 7. To go beyond divisive racial, religious, tribal, and sectarian constructs, and instead, contribute to a universal humanity.
