## **Campaign:** International Blasphemy Rights Day – Sept 30 2015

Friday, September 30 is International Blasphemy Rights Day. It is a day to celebrate the right to speaking freely about ideas and things such as religions, gods, sacred books, and profanity. Unfortunately, not everyone has the right to say what they want about these things—some countries will punish you with fines, imprisonment, and death if you are found guilty of blasphemy.

Even in societies such as the United States where religious freedom is celebrated, the criticism and questioning of others' religious beliefs is frowned upon and often met with derision and hostility.

The right to blaspheme is where the rights of free speech and religious freedom intersect. In order to have a truly democratic and open society, all citizens must be able to speak openly and honestly about all things—even another's religion, lack of religion, beliefs, gods, and sacred books—and be able to take the name of supernatural entities in vain: Holy Zeus!

## **Report:** Victorian Government changes to SRI

The Andrews Labor Government will introduce respectful relationships education into the school curriculum from next year to support students to learn how to build healthy relationships, understand global cultures, ethics and traditions, and to prevent family violence.

Respectful relationships education will be included in the curriculum from 2016 in Prep through to Year 10. It will focus on challenging negative attitudes such as prejudice, discrimination and harassment that can lead to violence, often against women.

The Government is also recognising the importance of world histories, cultures, and ethics. As part of the new Victorian Curriculum, this new content will be delivered by qualified teachers in all government schools.

These changes will help ensure Victoria remains a successful multicultural society and strengthen our diversity, one of our state's greatest assets. The capacity of our young people to understand others, including other world views, and to act with tolerance and respect, is an essential skill.

As part of these changes, from the start of Term 1, 2016, Special Religious Instruction (SRI) will be moved to lunchtimes or before or after school, freeing up 30 minutes of valuable class time per week.

Currently, while up to 20 per cent of primary school students participate in SRI, other students are missing out on essential learning time. The move means that teachers and students will be able to focus on core curriculum, learning the lessons and skills they need to be their best.



You probably did not hear about his case. And if you did, his fate may not have mattered much to you.

His name is difficult any way! Mohamed Cheikh Ould Mkhaitir. How do you pronounce such a name?

And his country? Mauritania! Among the poorest in the Middle East and North Africa. So remote, so poor, so far away.

His charge? Apostasy! Blasphemy. Again.

He was sentenced in December 2014 to death for writing an article that was construed as 'critical of Mohammed', the Prophet of Islam. Today, he awaits his execution.
