Sean Faircloth Tour of Australia – Report

Lawyer, politician and lobbyist, Sean Faircloth seems like the right man for the job to sell the value of secularism to the world on behalf of The Richard Dawkins

Foundation for Reason and Science. Sean provided much passion and direction in his recent tour of Australia.

During his tour, Sean highlighted the concern that the religious right are organising in Australia. Religious schools are on the rise in Australia and we have a major problem with religious influence in schools via the schools Chaplaincy and Special Religious Instruction programs in all our schools public and private.

The religious right are organising and so too do we need to organise to fight for a truly secular society. We need to build coalitions and networks with freethinking, secular AND religious groups. Our aim needs to be changing legislation to ensure a real separation of Church and State.

Our community needs to organise for science, reason, justice and compassion. We need to become leaders for human rights, secular values and morality. We need to overcome the tradition and doctrine that is preventing progress.

We need to give people something to care about that will motivate them to take action and participate in our movement. We need to work with legal and political experts to learn what can be done to protect and strengthen our secular democracy.

We need to actively lobby government, develop relationships with politicians and push for change. We need to develop working relationships with the United Nations.

Sean encouraged Australian free-thought groups to join forces and host Secular conventions with Australian speakers. He suggested that we develop local groups like Rotary all over Australia with a focus on lobbying for a true secular society.
