"Progressing Atheism a Victorian Atheist Conference 2013"

On June 1^{st} , atheists and freethinkers around Victoria convened in Melbourne for the first Victorian Atheist Conference. High on the Agenda were issues surrounding the upcoming election to be held on September, 2013.

Highlights included a proposal for an Atheist Lobby Group to promote secular principles. A cause to label Halal/Kosher meats was discussed by members and a call for volunteers was requested.

An important aspect of our community was brought forward by members with young children - Family friendly events and meetings should be considered when organising and arranging venues. A 14 point Atheist Manifesto is to be displayed on the PA website and finally a preliminary proposal on raising funds to secure permanent premises and create financial security was presented during the meeting. Another point of discussion was the use of radio and podcasts to reach out to a larger section of the public.

Dr John Perkins, president of the Secular Party of Australia, spoke of the financial burden religion imposes on Australians. Religious exemptions cost \$30 billion per year.
