<u>The Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child</u> <u>Sexual Abuse</u>

The commission's chief Janette Dines says the public should prepare themselves for the shocking details. Ms Dines has said 50000 have contacted the commission and another 2000 have expressed interest in coming forward.

"We believe the public will be shocked to begin to learn just how difficult life has been for people who have experienced child sexual abuse in an institution,"

Counsel Assisting Ms Gail Furness SC, has said the third public hearing in November is to examine the handling of complaints and civil litigation concerning child sexual abuse in the North Coast Children's Home by the Anglican Diocese of Grafton in 2006 and 2007.

Zoe's Law

Originally introduced into the NSW Parliament by Fred Nile and supported by the Attorney General and former president of the NSW Right to Life, Greg Smith, this bill seeks to change the law and award foetus personhood.

Chris Spence MP and *Brodie Donegan* have redrafted the bill but there are concerns that the bill still separates a woman from the foetus and has various women and legal groups opposing it. The debate has been adjourned.

ACT bill to legalise same sex marriage

The ACT Government says that same sex couples will be able to get married before the end of the year. The bill is expected to pass during this month's sittings with the support of the Green's MLA Shane Rattenbury and all eight Labor MLAs.
