Dear Professor Mohamed,

The formation and conquest of ISIS has been of great concern to many around the world. At this time it is essential that Islamic leaders speak out against the atrocities committed by ISIS in the name of Islam.

Your statement distancing “the pure teachings of Islam” from the crimes and atrocities committed by ISIS, and assuring us that “their misguided actions do not represent the overwhelming majority of Muslims” will offer relief to concerned Australians. We welcome your statement that Australians are united in wanting “peace and security for everyone regardless of religion.”

We live in a democratic and secular society that protects freedom of religion for all. This means that a person is free to join or leave a religion, based on their personal choice, without coercion or consequence.
